# Cracking the genetic code of bipolar disorder

## Federal Health Minister, mental health champions & researchers appealing for 5,000 Aussie volunteers for world's largest genetic bipolar disorder investigation

Today (November 20, 2018), the Federal Health Minister, mental health champions and researchers will issue a joint call for 5,000 adults who have been treated for bipolar disorder to volunteer for the world's largest investigation into the chronic mental illness1.

Identifying the genes that predispose people to bipolar disorder (which results in strong changes in mood and energy levels) will revolutionise future research into its causes, treatment and prevention1.

Approximately one in 50 Australians (1.8 per cent) will experience bipolar disorder during their lifetime<sup>2</sup>. The complex disorder which occurs commonly in families, typically results from a combination of genetic and environmental influences<sup>2</sup>. Those living with bipolar disorder also carry a 15 times greater risk of suicide than the general population, accounting for up to 25 per cent of all suicides<sup>2</sup>.
